Qualifications:

All our driving instructors are fully qualified Approved Driving Instructors (A.D.I)

Student Obligations & Legal Requirements:

Students must hold a valid UK provisional or full driving licence and present it on or before their first lesson.

Eyesight:

Students must be able to read a standard UK number plate from a distance of 20.5 meters (approx. 67 feet), using glasses or contact lenses if necessary.

Fitness:

Students must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs during lessons. Instructors reserve the right to terminate the lesson immediately if this occurs, and the lesson will still be charged.

Payments, Cancellations & Refunds Payments:

All lessons must be paid in advance or at the start of each lesson as agreed.

Cancellation Policy:

A minimum of 48 hours' notice is required to cancel or reschedule a driving lesson. If less than 48 hours notice is provided, the full lesson fee will be forfeited.

Block Bookings:

Pre-paid block bookings are generally non-refundable if you decide to stop lessons, though exceptions apply at the instructor's discretion.

Driving Test Booking:

Driving tests must be booked in agreement with the instructor to ensure the instructor and vehicle are available.

Vehicle Use:

The instructor reserves the right to withhold the use of their vehicle for the practical test if, in the instructor's opinion, the student's driving standard has not reached a safe standard,

Cancellation by DVSA:

The school is not responsible for test appointments cancelled or changed by the DVSA, and standard lesson fees will apply if short notice prevents re booking.
